HB 74 (Ware)	Undermines and creates exemption programs to the VCEA.	ANTI-VCEA	House C&E

HB 894 (Kilgore)	Exempts VCHEC from mandatory retirement dates in VCEA. Repeals certain EJ reporting requirements from VCEA. Encourages nuclear development.	ANTI-VCEA	House C&E
HB 1204 (Kilgore)	Undermines VCEA and corresponding RPS targets, and restricts APCB authority.	ANTI-VCEA	House C&E
HB 1257 (Kilgore)	Undermines VCEA goals by prohibiting public entities from banning natural gas, thereby slowing the transition to clean energy.	ANTI-VCEA	House C&E
HB 1261 (Bloxom)	Restructures appointment process for state environmental boards and restricts board authority.	ANTI-VCEA, ANTI-RGGI, ANTI-CLEAN CARS	Pending
SB 81 (Stanley)	Prohibits the Air Pollution Control Board from considering health, environmental, scientific, or economic factors when making regulations.	ANTI-VCEA, ANTI-RGGI, ANTI-CLEAN CARS	Senate Ag
HB 1326 (Kilgore)	Establishes that waste coal as fuel for electricity generation is in the public interest.	ANTI-VCEA	Pending
SB 120 (Hackworth)	Defines energy from waste coal as renewable & qualifies for RPS compliance. Exempts VCHEC from mandatory retirement dates in VCEA. Identical to HB 657.	ANTI-VCEA	Senate Ag, Energy Sub
SB 657 (Stuart)	Transfers existing regulatory authority of the APCB & SWCB to DEQ.	ANTI-VCEA, ANTI-RGGI, ANTI-CLEAN CARS	Senate Ag
HB 5 (Morefield)	Restructures existing RGGI allocation, giving 5% to a newly-created Fund.	ANTI-RGGI	House Ag
HB 892 (Kilgore)	Alters RGGI program compliance costs for entities with preexisting contracts. <i>Identical to SB 398.</i>	ANTI-RGGI	House C&E

SB 398 (McDougle)	Alters RGGI program compliance costs for entities with preexisting contracts. <i>Identical to HB 892.</i>	ANTI-RGGI	Senate Ag
SB 532 (Stuart)	Repeals the Clean Energy and Community Flood Preparedness Act, which authorizes Virginia's participation in the RGGI program. Identical to HB 1301.	ANTI-RGGI	Senate Ag
HB 1301 (Kilgore)	Repeals the Clean Energy and Community Flood Preparedness Act, which authorizes Virginia's participation in the RGGI program. Identical to SB 532.	ANTI-RGGI	Pending
HB 1267 (Wilt)	Effectively repeals Virginia's authority to adopt the Advanced Clean Car Standards.	ANTI-CLEAN CARS	Pending
