More Americans Are Concerned Than You May Think


75% TOTAL Are Very or Somewhat Concerned

■ Somewhat concerned


■ A little concerned




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Health Professionals: Highly Trusted Messengers

Percentage responding ethical standards and honesty are high or very high










Physical trauma and death


